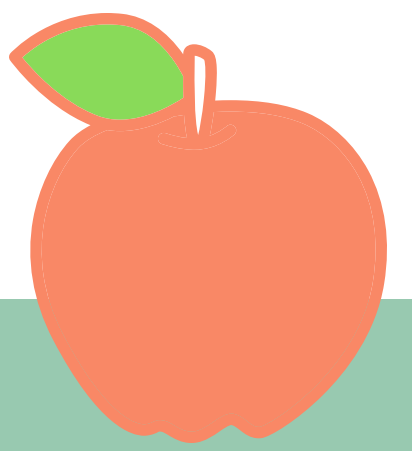

What was the intended purpose of this podcast? How do you know?

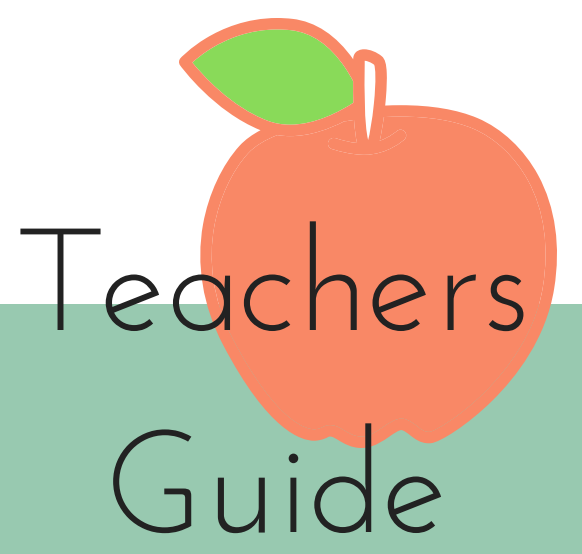

Podcast Discussion Guide

 **Before Listening** Write the focus question and your response before listening to the podcast.

Students write down a focus question that will guide their listening. This can be content based, speaking and listening based, or personal. Students should write the question and respond before listening.


 **While Listening** While listening, make notes of your own thoughts about the focus question and pause the podcast to capture evidence from the source for your thoughts.

Students can use additional paper as needed.

Evidence from Podcast

Encourage students to pause and write exact quotes that supports their ideas.
